NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

Installation of a new lighting installation to the main worship and ancillary areas of the Church to consist of new Illuma LED light fittings installed: Nave, Chancel, North Aisle and South Aisle. The Vestry, South Porch and Tower will have replacement LED round bulkhead lights fitted to existing wiring. The new lighting system will be fed from the existing distribution board which is located within the North Aisle. A new enclosure will be installed within this area which will house the Mode eDIN+ modules & over-current protection which will control all new lighting. A WIFI router shall also be installed to allow wireless operation and programming of the system. All as detailed in:

Directions to petitioner

You must display this public notice (or a copy of it) for a continuous period of not less than 28 days, not counting the day on which it was put up or the day on which it is taken down, (or for such other period as the Court may direct and subject to any special directions of the registrar) in each of the following places:

1. on a notice board or in some other prominent position inside the church; and
2. on a notice board outside the church or in some other prominent position (whether on the outside of the church door or elsewhere) so that it can be read by the public.
